




Installation Quick Start Guide for AQT-S2

Important Installation Instructions



- 1 Using filter knob, turn the old filter ¼ turn counter clockwise and remove from refrigerator.
- 2 Remove new filter from packaging take off red cap.
- 3 With the label facing down, insert the new filter into the filter receptacle. Turn the filter a ¼ turn clockwise so that the lock arrow is pointing up, and is aligned with arrow (See illustration).
- 4 Run water from the dispenser for 5 minutes at .5 gpm (about 2½ gallons) to clear the system and prevent sputtering.
- 5 Reset the filter replacement indicator light by holding down the Alarm (or Energy Saver) button for 3 seconds, or refer to your refrigerator owners manual.
- 6 Open the door to the refrigerator and check for leaks.
- 7 Attach the included water filter replacement calendar label according to the label instructions.

WARNING

A newly-installed water filter cartridge may cause water to spurt from the dispenser until all the air is removed. Do not use with water that is microbiologically unsafe or of unknown quality without adequate disinfection before or after the system.

Protect from freezing.

To reduce the risk of property damage due to water leakage, this filter MUST be installed in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications and instructions. This filter must be replaced every 6 months, at the rated capacity, or sooner if reduced water flow occurs. Failure to follow instructions and operation specifications will void your warranty. Further, manufacturer assumes no responsibility or liability for damages arising out of misuse of the product. The filter bypass plug MUST be used when a filter replacement cartridge is not installed.

The risk associated with small parts can cause choking if swallowed. Keep children away from small parts during the replacement of the water filter.
